



This was a year of growth for camperships at Camp Hawkeye and the Hawkeye Campership Fund has been there with Jess & Garrett making it happen. For the first time ever Camp Hawkeye camperships exceeded \$100,000.00! Through your generous contributions HCF helps fund new and returning campers attending Camp Hawkeye in Moultonborough, New Hampshire. In 2016 the total number of camperships increased to 71. Of this number 25 were new camperships given through HCF to youth from Massachusetts, New Hampshire and North Carolina. HCF's corporate sponsors have also expanded this year including a grant from the Natalie Bailey and Herbert J. Kirshner Foundation of New York, and donations from Sunday Hill Designs of California, Trader Joe's, Star Market, and Stop and Shop of Massachusetts.

Here are some of the happy faces of kids who received camperships for the summer of 2016:




Jane T. - grandmother of 2 campership recipients this year from Boston, MA, says:




John says, "Spending my summers at Camp Hawkeye is like going home to my family."
